# Robot Ready or something robot related

## **Robot Progression**

We are already half way through build season, and the competitions are swiftly approaching. Everyone has been working hard to prepare for this year's FIRST Robotics Competition. We've made significant progress these past three weeks, especially in the assembly of our proto-bot (prototype robot). The drive train is fully assembled, the electrical board is mounted, and thanks to the software team our drive train is fully functional. Software has put together an operational vision system on the proto-bot. Using a camera on the front of the robot, our drivers will be able to see the environment the robot is in. We will use the camera to navigate through the sandstorm period (a period during the first 15 seconds of the math where the robot isn't visible to the drivers) during competitions. Because we are far ahead mechanically, we have been able to discuss alternative design ideas for our robot that differ from the ones we previously discussed. Along with all the progress on the proto-bot, we have completed a prototype elevator and we are in the process of building our competition elevator, which we aim to have fully operational next week. We've used our momentum from last week to get ahead and we hope to have our competition robot operational by the end of next week.
